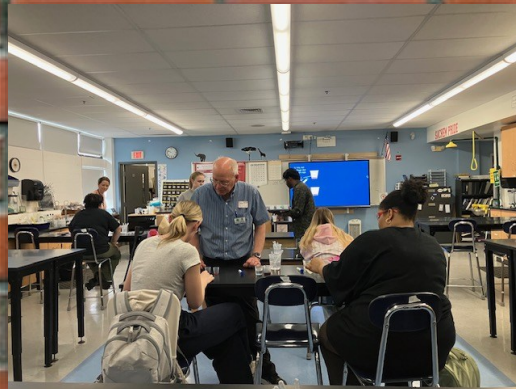

This view of Laconia Savings Bank, from Beacon Street West in November 2021, shows the 1971 structure, with a 1986 two-story addition at center and the solar-powered drive-up facility built in 1981 at left. The bank had relocated from Main Street, during Urban Renewal, to the former site of the Laconia City Hall, which had moved into the building, formerly a private hospital, but originally the home of John Adams Harper, congressman from New Hampshire from 1811-1813. Harper had moved from Sanbornton to Laconia in 1806 and died in 1816. A portion of the Real Life Church (earlier, home to Goodwill Industries, still earlier to Laconia Hardware and an A&P supermarket, but built in 1930 as the Crosby Buick Garage) is seen at right.
