Over the past week the Laconia Fire Department has received multiple calls to our NON-EMERGENCY phone number [\(603-524-6881\)](tel:(603)524-6881) for brush fires, car accidents and medical emergencies and, in one case, an emergency in another community. This non-emergency number is for the business offices for the Laconia Fire Department and the folks who answer it do not have the ability to process emergency calls, nor to dispatch emergency vehicles.

It is always better to call 911 and give them the information so they may notify the appropriate dispatch center to have the correct agency and resources respond to your emergency in a timely fashion. Thank you!





## Dementia Caregiver Support Group




