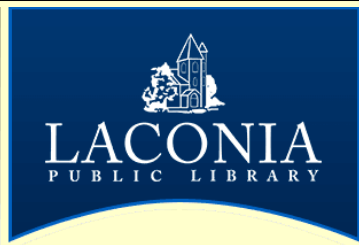

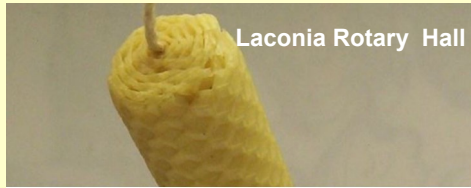
Reconstruction work on Court Street is underway! Local businesses and residents will be able to access their property during the construction. Some delays may occur in the area as work progresses.

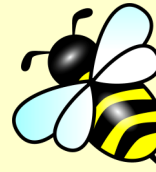

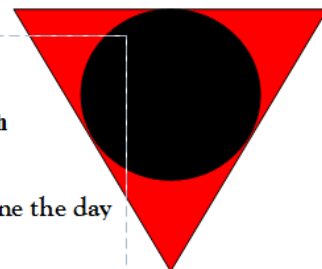

May 2 – Spring is Here!

After a long cold winter, it is so exciting to see birds coming back, flowers in bloom and plants turning green! We'll read one of our favorite books – *Possum & the Peeper*, then see how many signs of spring we can find on a walk around Prescott Farm.

May 9 – Sneaky Salamanders

Did you know that salamanders and newts are all around us? Though they are pretty sneaky and not often seen by people, there are a ton of them in the forest! 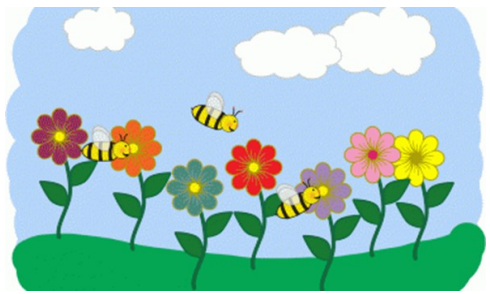
