For Fire or Medical Emergencies Please Call 911!

The Laconia Fire Department has seen an increase recently of emergency calls coming directly into our fire stations, and not going through 911. It is important to remember that the fire station does not house the fire dispatch center, and if all of our personnel are out of the building there will not be anyone there to answer the phone. This could delay getting you help. The best way to receive fire and ambulance services in the case of an emergency is to dial 911. They will answer your call, assist you as needed, and rapidly transfer you to a dispatch center so appropriate personnel and apparatus can be sent.

There have been a few changes to Medicare for 2019 that we would like to make beneficiaries aware of.

If you receive Extra Help you will no longer be able to change your plan anytime. If you need to make a change it will now be available once per calendar quarter in the first three quarters of the year (January-March, April-June, and July-September). Changes become effective the following month.

Beginning in 2019, there is a **Medicare Advantage Open Enrollment Period** beginning January 1 through March 31 each year. During this time, beneficiaries enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan will have one opportunity to change their Medicare Advantage plan or go back to Original Medicare with or without a stand-alone Part D prescription drug plan. Changes take effect the first of the following month.


