### **Synopsis of Event:**

On February 19<sup>th</sup> 2019, The Laconia Police Responded to the Vista Foods Parking lot near the Laconia Rod and Gun for a report of an assault. When Officers arrived they were advised of a female who had been struck in the face. The victim reported that she was sitting in her vehicle in the parking lot near South Main Street and the exit to Vistas. When an unknown female entered the passenger's side door of her vehicle. This female proceeded to punch the victim in the face and then steal personal items and the keys for the vehicle from the victim. The female was last seen running up South Main Street towards downtown. The victim was treated at LRGH for facial injuries. The suspect is described as;

**White female**

**Late 20's early 30's**

**Medium build**

**Brown hair**

**Lip ring**

**Black knit cap**

**Black Sweatshirt**

**Possibly with a backpack**
